TO: **CONTRACTORS PERFORMING WORK UNDER THE LABORERS'
UTILITY MASTER AGREEMENT**

Gentlemen:

Under the terms of the Laborers' Utility Master Agreement, the Southern California District Council of Laborers has allocated the increase effective August 1, 2011, as set forth herein: \$1.00 to Health and Welfare, \$.04 to Administrative Trust and \$0.96 to Wages for the 11 Southern California Counties. For San Diego County: \$1.00 for Health and Welfare, \$0.04 to Laborers Trusts' Administrative Trusts' Fund, \$0.10 to Vacation (Supplemental Dues) and \$0.86 to wages.

Foreman: Laborer Foreman employed in accordance with this Agreement shall be paid not less than \$1.75 per hour more than the hourly rate of the highest paid Laborer over whom they have leadership on their regular crew. In the event the Contractor at his option elects to use a Laborer Foreman to supervise other Laborer Foreman, he shall be paid not less than \$1.00 per hour more than the hourly rate of the highest classified Laborer Foreman over whom he has leadership. As an exception to the dispatch procedure contained in Section 6, the Union may dispatch workers requested by the Contractor as Laborer Foreman, who are not next in order on the out-of-work list.

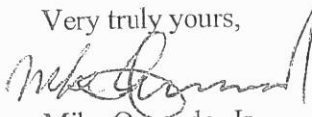
